INFORMATION ON VETERAN'S PAVERS MT. ZION HISTORICAL PARK

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A VETERAN'S PAVER IN THE MT. ZION VETERANS WALKWAY THE VETERAN:

1. Born in Jay or Benezette Townships
2. Buried in Jay or Benezette Townships
3. Lived in Jay or Benezette for 10 or more years
4. A member of Valley Legion Post for 10 or more years
5. A member of the Chapter 720 Vietnam Veterans of America

The cost of Veteran's Paver is \$65.00. Pavers are free for those Veterans who meet the above qualification and are among one of the following categories.

1. Having served in military prior to beginning of World War II, or
2. Having been Killed in Action, or
3. Having been Missing in Action, or
4. Having been a Prisoner of War.

Notes on the Application.

1. The name on the veteran's paver will be the same as submitted on the form. Some prefer to indicate the rank or pay scale. The website contains a Rank Insignia Chart of the U.S. Army Forces to aid in your decision. For example, An E6 in the army would be a Staff Sergeant. In this case you have three options:
 - a. TO LIST THE NAME ONLY,
 - b. TO LIST E6,
 - c. TO LIST STAFF SERGEANT WHICH WOULD BE ABBREVIATED "S SGR".
2. Those who served during a war are listed as veteran of that war, and their paver will be located in that section of the walkways.
3. When submitting your application, the Society would be most grateful for a picture of the Veteran in uniform for posting on the Veteran's List.
4. All pavers received prior to April 1st will be dedicated in that same year at the part annual dedication, which is scheduled the Saturday before Memorial Day.
5. BRANCH OF SERVICE: LIST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine, Coast Guard, or Peace Time.
